This is the Dodgem pay box.</p> <p>Check location as suitable for this mode of supervision.</p> <p>Ensure pupils are sufficiently briefed and competent. (Any individual pupils for whom indirect supervision is not suitable must be directly supervised).</p> <p>Clear guidelines and emergency procedures understood.</p> <p>Pupils to remain in pairs or groups such as a buddy system-each responsible for named other.</p> <p>Rendezvous points and times set.</p> <p>Staff understand they are still responsible.</p> <p>Parents informed of possible indirect supervision and consent obtained.</p>	<p>Include in information to parents.</p> <p>Brief students on safe and acceptable behaviour.</p>	Medium

Vehicle traffic	Injury, death	Pupils and staff	The park is closed to vehicular traffic except emergency vehicles. There is designated car/coach parking. Care should be taken in the car/coach parks with regards to the movement of vehicles in the vicinity of pedestrians.	rides High visibility jackets should be worn. Relevant group procedure should be applied in the car/coach park. Use pedestrian access once being dropped off at the coach park via the promenade.	Medium
Rides	Injury, death	Pupils and staff	Rides undergo rigorous testing in accordance with manufacture guidelines. Rides are operated by trained staff.	Be aware of health and safety executive document HSG175. All safety restrictions must be adhered to at all times.	Low
Slips, trips and falls	Injury, death	Pupils and staff	Pedestrian circulation areas are checked regularly and kept free of hazards. Surfaces can become wet in bad weather. Ground underfoot can be uneven. Steps are present within the park and on rides.	Note the presence of wet floors in bad weather. Care must be taken when boarding and disembarking rides. No running.	Medium
Strobe lighting	Discomfort, panic, injury	Pupils and staff	A few of the rides feature strobe lighting. This information can be found at each ride.	Note ride features and select appropriate rides for individuals.	Low
Reduced lighting	Panic, injury, trip, fall	Pupils and staff	A few of the rides and attractions do use reduced lighting as part of the experience.	Note ride features and select appropriate for individuals.	Low
Enclosed spaces	Discomfort, panic	Pupils and staff	Some of the rides and attractions can be quite small in area and to some individuals these may feel confined. However no public area on the park can be defined as a confined space.	Note ride features and select appropriate rides for individuals	Low
